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### SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY

- Player Safety
- Minimum Requirements for Junior Rugby Union Matches at Rugby Park

| STEP | DESCRIPTION OF ACTION   | RESPONSIBLE    |
|------|---|----------------|
| 1.   | Smart Rugby Qualified Coaches   | Clubs          |
| 2.   | First Aid Personnel – Minimum Requirement Basic First Aid Certificate   | Clubs          |
| 3.   | First Aid , Sports Trainer and Medical personnel should be clearly visible in brightly colored uniform/vests (ie orange, yellow, etc), and easily identifiable from teams | Clubs          |
| 4.   | First Aid Kit   | NT Rugby Union |
| 5.   | Ice   | NT Rugby Union |
| 6.   | Stretcher (preferable scoop stretcher) for use by trained personnel   | NT Rugby Union |
| 7.   | Emergency contacts for nearest hospital, doctor, dentist, etc   | NT Rugby Union |
| 8.   | Telephone (for use in emergency)  | NT Rugby Union |
| 9.   | Emergency vehicle access for Ambulance providing clear entry  | NT Rugby Union |
| 10.  | Safety Poster in a suitable location visible to Rugby stakeholders  | NT Rugby Union |

### OTHER INFORMATION

- NT Rugby Union will endeavor to provide suitably qualified medical personnel for matches at Rugby Park, however the underlying responsibility will be for Clubs to assume responsibility for the Medical requirements of their players.
